# **OCTOBER WOODYISM**

Well September is in the rear view mirror and October lies ahead. October brings with it pumpkin spice flavored everything, the second to the last month of this year's hurricane season, the beginning of "FLU" season, and the end of "Oktoberfest". **Oktoberfest** (German spelling) is the world's largest Volksfest (beer festival). held annually in Munich, Bavaria, Germany. It is a 16- to 18-day folk festival running from mid or late September to the first Sunday in October, with more than six million people from around the world attending the event every year. In Bavaria, it is often called the *Wiesn*, after the colloquial name for the fairgrounds, Theresa's meadows (*Theresienwiese*). The Oktoberfest is an important part of Bavarian culture, having been held since the year 1810. The first **Oktoberfest** began on October 12, 1810 to celebrate the marriage of Crown Prince Ludwig, who later became King Ludwig I. His marriage to Princess Therese von Sachsen-Hildburghausen was celebrated in Bavaria and all citizens were invited to a two week feast to celebrate the marriage. Other cities across the world also hold Oktoberfest celebrations that are modeled after the Munich festival

During the Munich festival, large quantities of Oktoberfest Beer are consumed. In 2016, for example, 7.7 million liters; (66,000 barrels); (2,041,600 gallons) were served. Visitors also enjoy numerous attractions, such as amusement rides, craft vendors, and games. There is also a wide variety of traditional foods available.

The Munich Oktoberfest traditionally took place in the 16-day period leading up to the first Sunday in October. But in 1994, this longstanding schedule was modified in response to German reunification to incorporate German Unity Day during the festival. With this change, if the first Sunday in October falls on the 1st or the 2nd, then the festival would run until 3 October (German Unity Day). Thus, the festival now runs for 17 days when the first Sunday is 2 October and 18 days when it is 1 October. In 2010, the festival lasted until the first
