October is in the rear-view mirror and November is on the front bumper. Today November 1st is the end of Daylight Savings Time. Hopefully, you turned your clock back an hour when you went to bed yesterday, giving us a long weekend of 49 hours.

Election Day is on Tuesday, the 3rd of November. Election Day for federal offices occurs on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November.

The Marine Corps was established on November 10, 1775, and the Vietnam Memorial was dedicated in Washington DC on November 13, 1982.

Veterans Day when we honor those, who have served in the United States Armed Forces, falls annually on November 11. It also coincides with Armistice Day and Remembrance Day, which mark the end of World War I.

President John F. Kennedy was assassinated in Parkland Texas on November 22, 1963.

Thanksgiving, perhaps the most popular of all-American holidays after Christmas, is celebrated each year on the fourth Thursday of November. This year it is on November 26th. Normally Americans have the chance on this day to gather with friends and family over a sumptuous meal and they also get to enjoy a rare four-day weekend (with the Friday afterward, known as Black Friday, marking the traditional start of the Christmas shopping season). This year because of the pandemic we have been cautioned to limit or forego large family gatherings for Thanksgiving and many stores have declared the entire month of November as Black Friday shopping. Black Friday is so called because retail stores make sufficient sales (profit) to make their balance sheet go from red to black.
