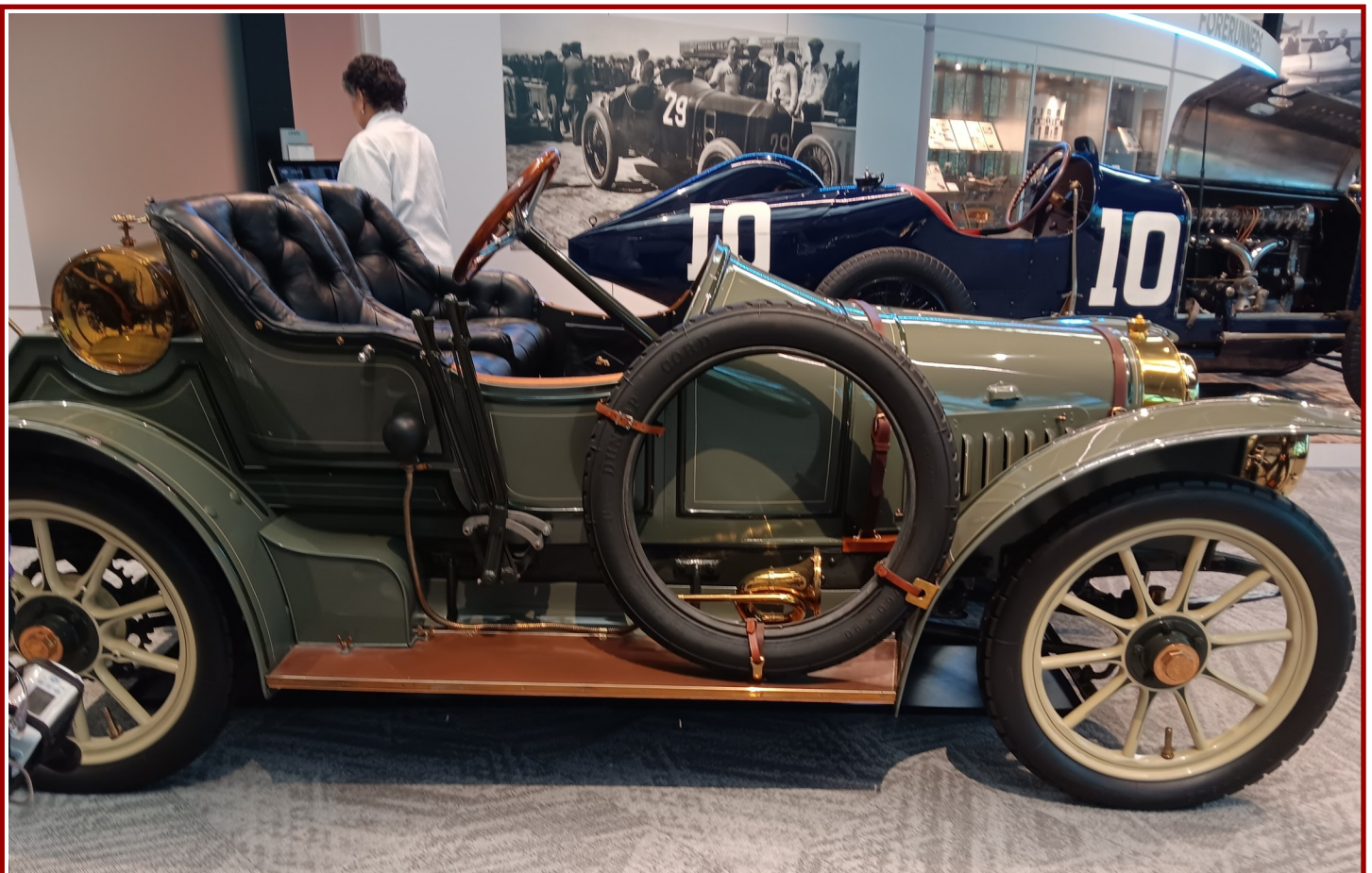
We saw many rare cars, one that caught my eye was an 1894 model, beautiful craftsmanship. It's top speed was 16mph.
