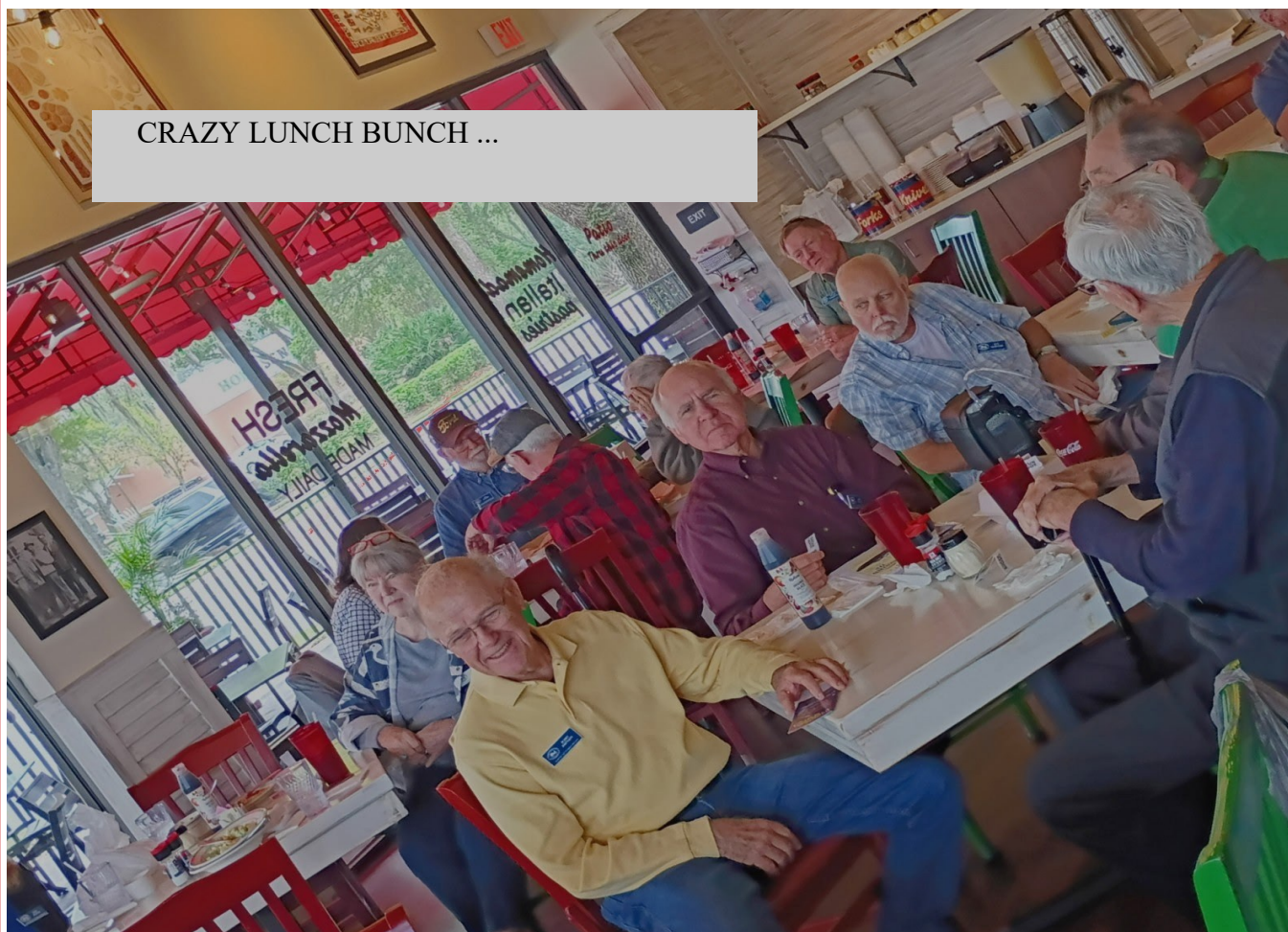
FSCJ CAR SHOW REPORT – APRIL 11
